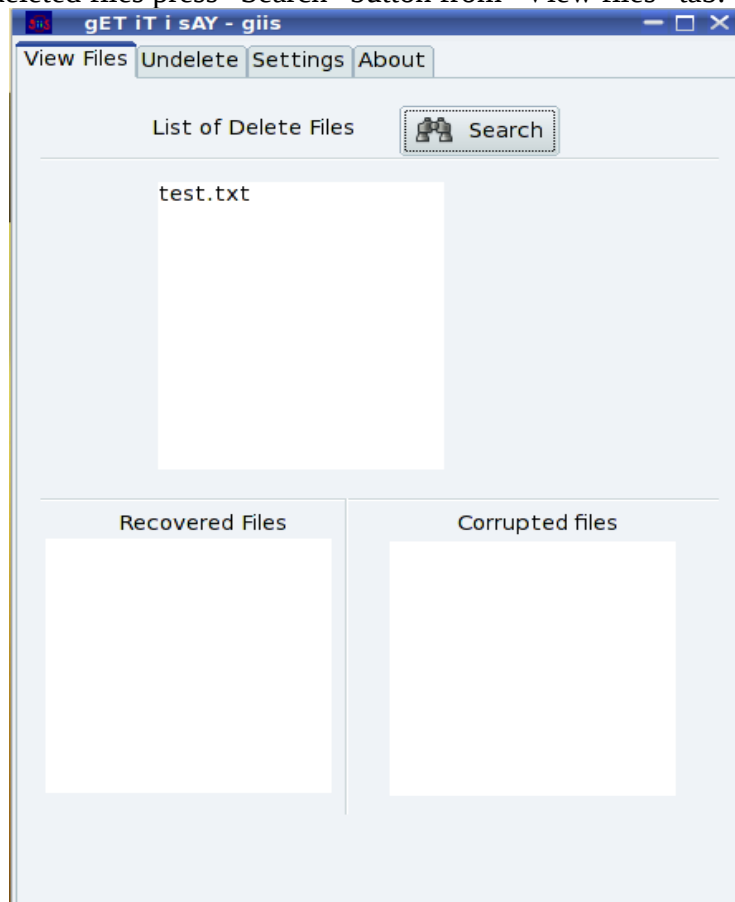
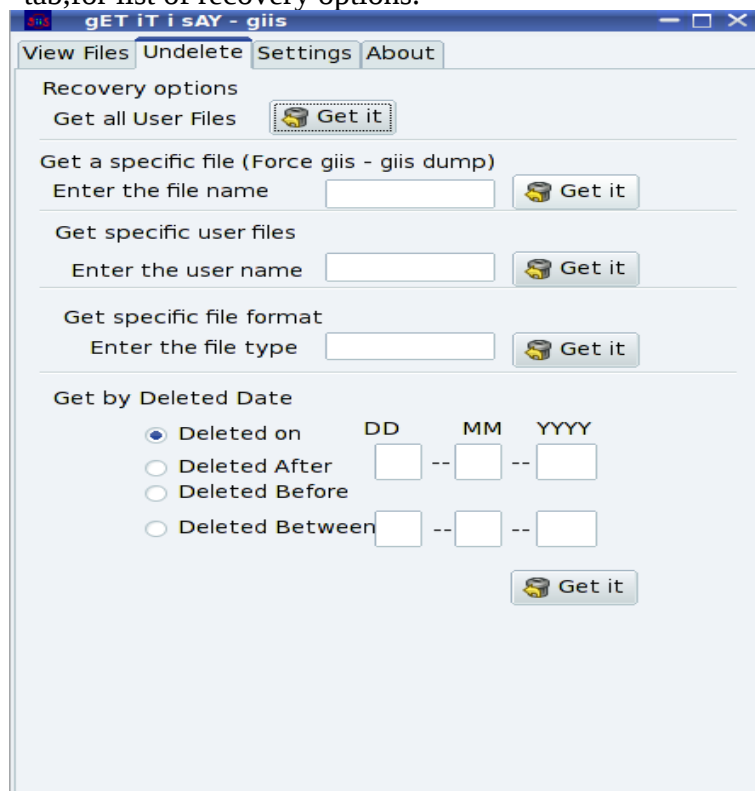


## giis-gui

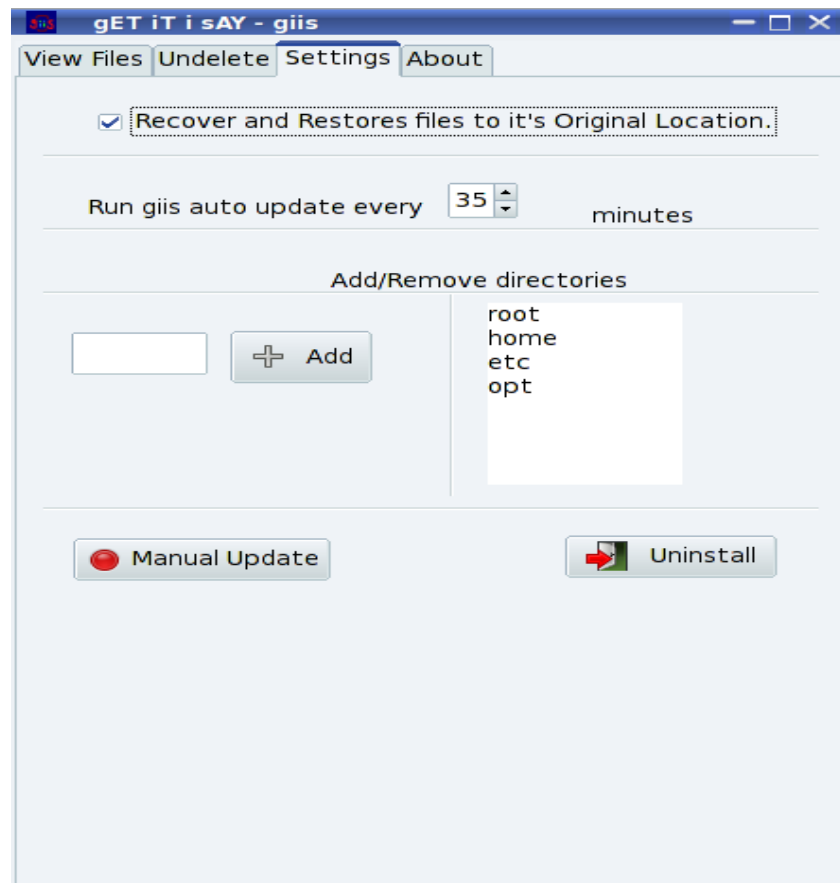
To view the List of deleted files press “Search” button from “View files” tab.



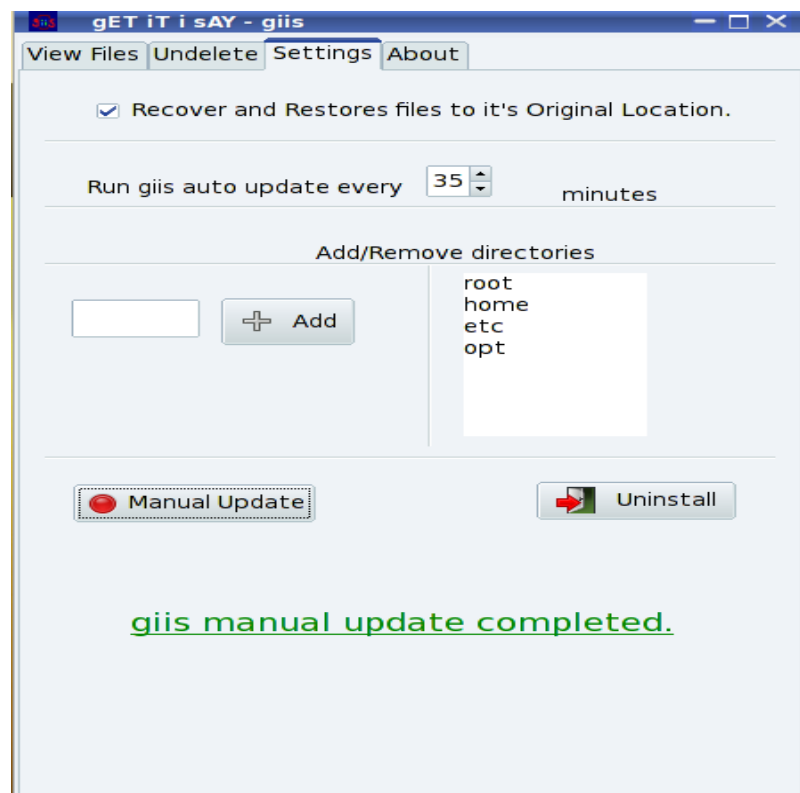
Click on “Undelete” tab, for list of recovery options.



Recover and Restore feature allows recovered files to be place in it's original location.  
To add new directories or to modify the auto update time press “Settings” tab.

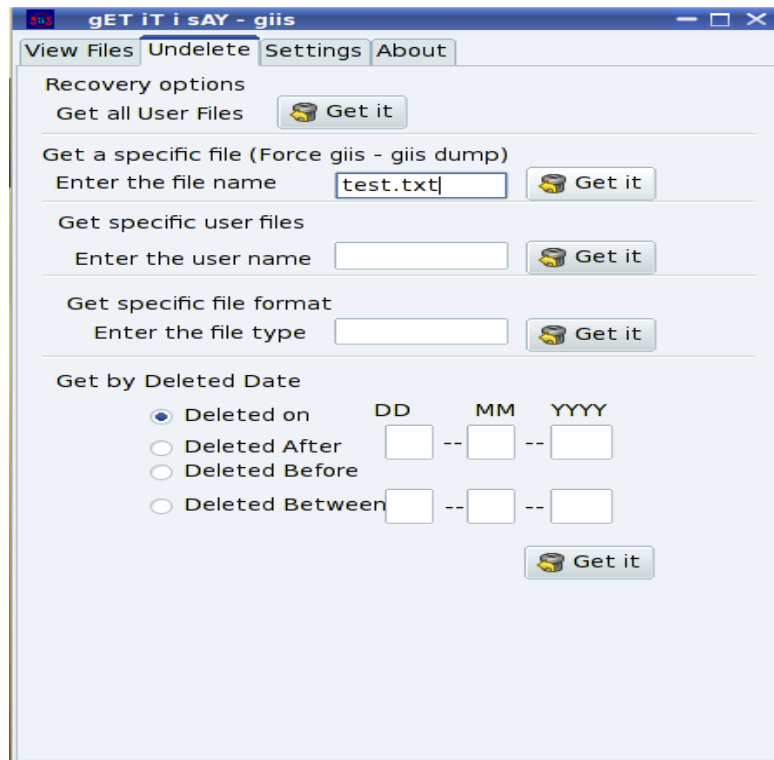


As you can see giis auto updates every 35 minutes on /etc and /opt directories along with /root and /home. Press “Manual Update” so that giis reflects current file system state of chosen directories. And a message “giis manual update completed” will be shown.



### Sample Recovery:

If you know the file name to recover then choose feature “**Get a Specific file (Force giis – giis dump)**” and Enter the file name (test.txt) that needs to be recovered.



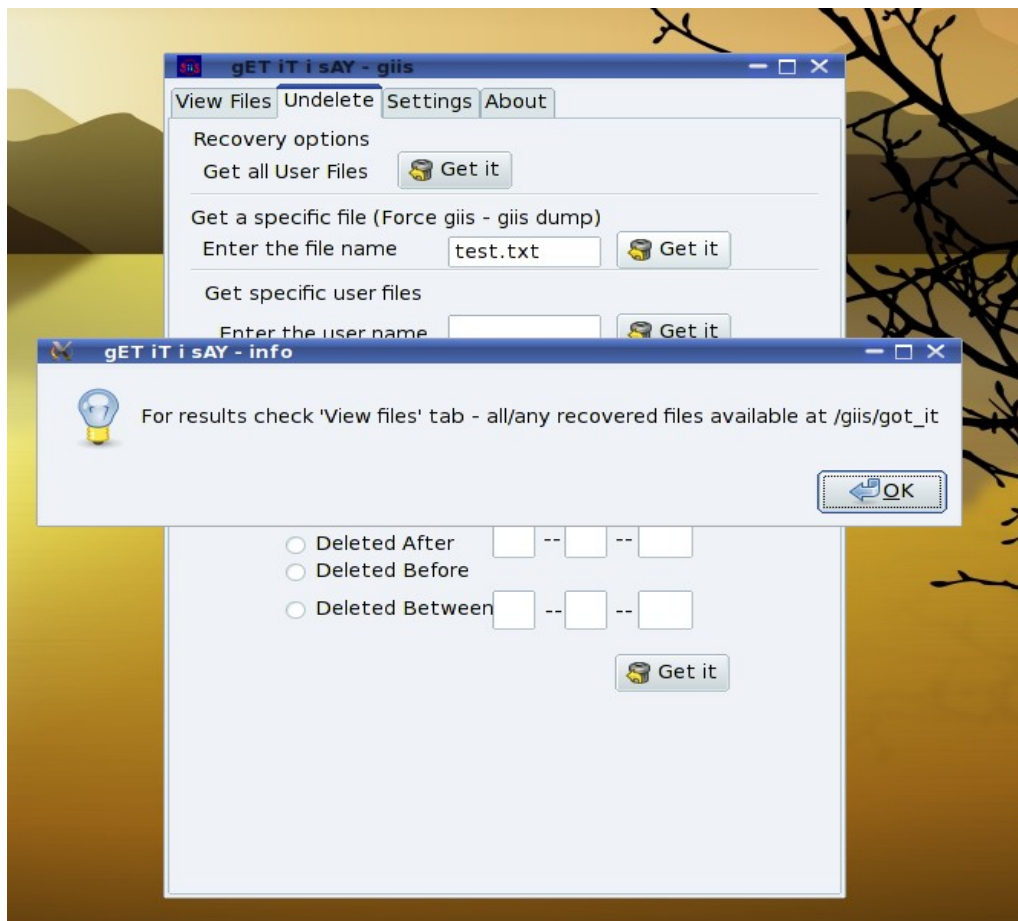
Choosing “**Get Specific user files**” will recover all files by their owner. Say you want to recover file of user named “**Lakshmi**” then simply use above option ,it will recover the deleted Lakshmi's files.

Choosing “**Get all user files**” will recover deleted files of all users available on the system.

To recover all **png** files ,use the option “**Get Specific file format**” and enter the file type as **png**. You can specify any file format you wish to recover. (say mp3,c,java,gif etc)

To recover files deleted on specific date or before/after a given date you can choose the final feature “**Get by deleted date**”. You can also chose the date range,so that all files deleted between the given dates can be recovered.

Press “Get it”.will display following message (see next screenshot) after recovery and recovered files always found under **/giis/got\_it** directory.



Check "View files" tab's recovered files will show recovered files.
